Soma Glick is a Diplomate in Acupuncture and Herbology and holds a D.O.M. from NM and is a Lic.Ac. in CO as well as a certified Classical Homeopath.



After graduating from the International Institute of Chinese Medicine in Santa Fe, New Mexico she has completed internships in Beijing, China and Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam. She studied Pediatric Sho-Ni-Shin with Miki Shima (a Japanese Sho-Ni-Shin Master). She was a professor at the Southwest Acupuncture College in Boulder, Colorado from 1998 to 2005 where she developed and taught the Pediatric Acupuncture course and taught many other core curriculum classes. She ran the professional pediatric clinic and personally mentored several students.

In 2003, Soma started teaching weekend seminars on pediatric acupuncture around the world. She has taught with Jake Fratkin at the CSOMA symposium in San Francisco and lectured on treating children with Oriental Medicine at the Boulder Community Hospital. She was invited to speak on healing and spirituality in India and Singapore.

In 2005 she moved to the island of Bali and donated one day a week to the children's clinic of the Bumi Sehat birthing center in Ubud. She also conducted numerous intensive courses teaching pediatrics and obstetrics to licensed acupuncture practitioners and offering clinics to the poor local Balinese population.

In 2013 Soma returned to Boulder and has resumed her professor position at SWAC, teaching the pediatric class and clinic and reopening her private practice.. Soma has been published in "the Journal of Chinese Medicine" and in "Acupuncture Today".

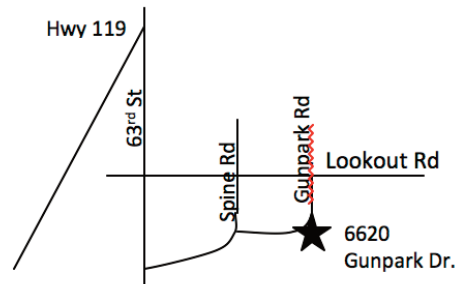
